A Notice to Contributors Concerning Style and Deadlines

The Executive Committee invites submissions of manuscripts to the Editor and from authors of papers presented at the 2025 annual meeting on March 1, 2025, at Francis Marion University. On the recommendations of reviewers and editors, manuscripts may be published in *The Journal of the South Carolina Historical Association*.

Manuscripts should fall between 4,500 to 7,500 words including endnotes (between eighteen and thirty double-spaced pages). Manuscripts for review should be submitted as soon as possible, after the annual meeting, but the final deadline for the *2026 Journal* will be Monday, June 2, 2025. Authors should submit a digital copy by email attachment (email subject line "2026 Journal Paper Submission") in Microsoft Word. The electronic text should be flush left and double spaced, with as little special formatting as possible. Do not paginate the electronic version of the paper. All copies should use the 12-point type in Times New Roman font. The title of the paper should be at the top of the manuscript's first page, in bold. Please use margins of one inch throughout your paper and space only once between sentences. Indent the first lines of paragraphs one-half inch. Indent one-half inch all quotation marks five or more lines in length. In your email, please include your full name and organizational affiliation, your email address, and your U.S. postal address.

Citations should be provided in endnotes, **not** at the foot of each page. At the end of the text of your paper double-space, then type the word "NOTES" centered between the margins. List endnotes in Arabic numerical sequence, each number followed by a period and space, and then the text of the endnote. Endnotes should be flush left and single-spaced. If your word-processing program demands the raised footnote numeral, it will be accepted. Foreign words and titles of books or journals should be italicized. Please remove all hyperlinks. In other matters of style, *The Journal of the South Carolina Historical Association* adheres to *The Chicago Manual of Style*.

Authors will be notified of the status of their papers by **Monday, August 25, 2025**. Papers accepted for publication have *one month* after this date to make changes and revisions based on reviewers' and editors' comments. Contributors assume responsibility for factual accuracy and for citation of sources.
